JAFFNA DISTRICT

Situation update

- The situation remained tense in Jaffna with intermittent shelling towards FDL areas.

Displacement>Returns

- No new displacement or return took place during period under review.
- UNHCR continues to monitor IDPs living in 11 Temporary Accommodation centers (TACs)/welfare centers as well as IDP living with host families. There are currently 11 TACs– five in Karaveddy, three in Chavakachcheri, and three in Jaffna.
- The GA Jaffna hosted a meeting with various humanitarian agencies, representatives of IDP families from Allaipiddy and local authorities to share the plan of action for return of 65 families. The GA reiterated his intention to organize this return in accordance with the Guiding Principles on Internal Displacement.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- WFP Jaffna warned that the food aid programme may experience shortfalls of cereals, sugar, oil and CSB for the March distributions if the shipments of 1,800 MT allocated for March 2008 fails to arrive in Jaffna.
- NFRI distributions and shelter assistance continues for IDPs.

- 7 March, the GA chaired a meeting at the Jaffna Secretariat to review the achievements of 2007 and discussed the challenges for 2008. Participants included Heads of Local Authorities, Heads of Divisional Secretariats, Zonal Education Departments, health service personnel, the Municipal Administration, Heads of Local Government Administration, MPCS Multi Purpose Cooperative Societies and WFP Jaffna office
- 7 March, UNDP held a progress review meeting at the Agrarian Service Centre in Alaveddy for the agro well renovation project in Tellipalai DS and the planned renovation of another 4 agro wells.

KILINOCCHI & MULLAITIVU DISTRICTS

And Manthai West (located in Mannar district but covered by Kilinochchi district)

Situation update

- Tension in Kilinochchi increased following the killing of a Tamil MP. In addition, daily armed confrontations, exchange of mortar/artillery fire at the northern and southern FDL areas is contributing to fear and insecurity.
- Uyilankulam entry/exit point has been closed for movements since 3 September 2007.
- At the 4 March, meeting between the Security Forces-Vanni commandant and GAs in Vavuniya, it was agreed that empty Lorries from Vanni to government controlled areas would be allowed through the checkpoint on Saturdays. Last Saturday 08 March, 71 Lorries were allowed from Vanni last Saturday.

Displacement>Returns

- No new displacements were reported.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- There has been no approval from the MoD to transport food items for general public consumption through the Omanthai entry/ exit point into Kilinochchi district. 11 March, GA-Kilinochchi reported that the supplies for February and March, have not been transported.
- 12 March, RDHS office-Kilinochchi reported that no MoD authorization has been granted to transport the first quarter essential drugs stored in Vavuniya.

MANNAR & VAVUNIYA DISTRICTS

Situation update

- The general situation across Mannar and Vavuniya District remains tense and volatile.
- Procedures at the Omanthai entry/ exit point remain tight civilian and humanitarian organization movements.
- Since 4 February, access has been restricted to vehicles north of Madawachchiya checkpoint, creating additional challenges for civilian travel across Mannar District. Restrictive procedures at checkpoints on the A14 road, including Uyilankulam, continue to cause serious problems with the supply of essential items, and are also resulting in price increases and fuel shortages.

Displacement>Returns

- 22 IDP families displaced from villages in the periphery of Vavuniya North further north of Vavuniya.
- 17 IDP families who came from Manthai West are camping in Kalimodai in Nanaddan DS, Mannar as the SLA did not allow them to reside with host families.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- OXFAM completed a livelihood needs assessment of Musali IDPs in Mannar District and selected 272 IDP families to receive fishing gear.

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT

Situation update

- 8-12 March, Trincomalee district experienced heavy rain, which resulted in flooding in Kinniya DS division (Faizal Nagar, Annal Nagar, Manchcholaichenai, Rahumaniya Nagar, Idiman and Alankerny). Paddy fields in Gomarankadawala DS division and Vilpanakulam, Kalyanapura and Vevkadawela were flooded. Water levels have now receded.
- The Disaster Risk Management Centre in Trincomalee reported that 582 families (2,669 individuals) in Trincomalee Town and Gravets DS division were affected by the flooding. Government authorities/CBO/NGOs provided cooked meals to affected individuals.

Displacement>Returns

- Government authorities planned to resettle 150 families to Pallikkudiyiruppu (within Muttur East/Sampoor High Security Zone) on 12 March. This has now been postponed to 15 March due to the local government elections in Batticaloa district.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- NRC has finalized their revised core shelter design which has been shared with members of Shelter Coordination Cell (SCC). However, due to delays in resettlement to Muttur East the design has not yet been discussed with potential beneficiaries. Considerable differences between the shelter budgets for the 2 districts also constrain the implementation of the revised core shelter design.

BATTICALOA DISTRICT

Situation update

- Batticaloa district local government elections were held on 10 March as planned. The United People's Freedom Alliance (supported by TMVP) took the majority of seats in the Batticaloa Municipal Council, whilst TMVP won the majority of seat in all 9 contested Pradesha Sabha's. These two parties took 75% of the 101 seats. No major security incident occurred during the election/ counting days. During this period, there was a high presence of security forces with sections of town closed off for 3 days.

Displacement>Returns

- UNHCR reports that the Government has plans to resettle the IDPs of Vahanery and Poolakadu area in Kiran DS division as the first area of return in Kiran. The resettlement is likely to occur after 15 March according to government sources.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- WASH actors are conducting assessments on the 21 IDP camps in the district to identify needs for repairs & upgrades to WASH facilities, which will be compiled into a WASH Sector Action Plan. WASH focal points and responsible responding agencies have confirmed commitments for continued WASH support to all 21 IDP Camp locations. Essential sanitation services are continuing through the Municipal Council Batticaloa and Pradeshiya Sabhas, although gaps in garbage collection and gully sucking services in some IDP camps occurred due to the Local Government elections.
- There is an estimated 70% gap in Complementary Food assistance for IDPs in welfare centres.

AMPARA DISTRICT

Situation update

- Security situation remains tense in the coastal parts of Ampara district.

Displacement>Returns

- UNHCR reports that there are presently 1490 families consisting of 5569 individuals displaced in the district.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- A rapid assessment was conducted by UNICEF team on Pre-Schools needs in two conflict affected villages in Damana DS division (Pannalgama & Bakmityawa). Physical needs and health and nutrition needs were identified in 6 Pre-Schools and these findings were shared with UN team and I/NGOs and MOMCH Ampara.
- Based on the identified needs relief items were distributed by UNICEF for 6 Pre-Schools benefiting more than 140 students. UNICEF is also advocating with the RDHS Ampara to conduct outreach clinics in Bakmityawa area to cover immunization and other health related gaps.
